## International Women's Rights Activist to speak at Walk for Life West Coast

San Francisco, January 16, 2017 – Organizers of the 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Walk for Life West Coast invite everyone to join them on January 21, 2017 in San Francisco to continue proclaiming a powerful message that has been present since its beginning over a decade ago: there is hope and healing from abortion, women deserve better than abortion, and as a society we have to do better. Reggie Littlejohn, the Founder and President of Women's Rights Without Frontiers, will be speaking on this important message at the rally before the Walk.

Reggie's organization, <u>Women's Rights Without Frontiers</u>, is an international coalition to expose and oppose forced abortion, gendercide and sexual slavery in China. Reggie also led the international effort to free blind activist Chen Guangcheng, who arrived in the United States on May 19, 2012.

Women's Rights Without Frontiers seeks to form a left-right, human rights and humanitarian coalition to end forced abortion and gendercide. Both pro-life and pro-choice venues have embraced this message. Reggie received the National Pro-Life Recognition Award at the 40th March for Life in Washington, DC on January 25, 2013. She was also the keynote speaker for the 2013 March for Life Canada in Ottawa, and for the 2013 National Right to Life Convention in Dallas.

An acclaimed international expert on China's One Child Policy, Reggie has testified six times at the United States Congress, three times at the European Parliament, and she has presented at the British, Irish and Canadian Parliaments as well. Her first address at the European Parliament redefined the debate about China's One Child Policy, revealing it to be systematic, state-sponsored violence against women.

The 2017 Walk for Life West Coast will begin at 12:30 PM with a rally in the city's Civic Center Plaza. Along with Reggie Littlejohn, speakers include <u>Pam Tebow</u>, abortion survivor <u>Melissa Ohden</u>, and Rev. Childress, founder of <u>Black Genocide.org</u>

Following the rally, participants will walk down Market Street to Justin Herman Plaza.

Founded in 2005 by a group of San Francisco Bay Area residents, the Walk for Life West Coast's mission is to change the perceptions of a society that thinks abortion is an answer.
