Pro-Life Heroine Pam Tebow to join 2017 Walk for Life West Coast!

Heisman winner's Mom to Share Faith and Hope at San Francisco Event

San Francisco, October 18, 2016 – The Walk for Life West Coast is thrilled to announce that Pam Tebow will be joining the 13th Annual Walk for Life West Coast in San Francisco on January 21, 2017.

"We're so excited to have Pam with us!" said Eva Muntean, a co-founder of the Walk. "You know, when most people think of Pam they think of her as the mother of the Heisman Trophy winner Tim Tebow, but Tim is only here because Pam listened to the Lord, and refused to abort him when doctors advised her to do so—even though her life was in danger. That's as pro-life as it gets! We are delighted to have her as one of our keynote speakers, sharing her message of faith and hope!"

Pam and her husband Bob have five children, each of whom was homeschooled, and each of whom received a college scholarship. For a number of years they served as missionaries in the Philippines, where Bob, with Pam's help, still has a presence through the Bob Tebow Evangelistic Association. They also run an orphanage in the Philippines, which has been a home to scores of orphans since it opened in 1992.

Pam's famous interview with ESPN, where she described her refusal to abort "Timmy," gave her, as she says "... a national platform to encourage the pro-life message. In 2010, Pam and Tim were in a Super Bowl commercial that celebrated family and life, which, according to a Barna survey, resulted in 5.5 million people 'having cause to rethink their stand on abortion."

The 2017 Walk for Life West Coast will begin at 12:30 PM with a rally in the city's Civic Center Plaza. Along with Pam Tebow, speakers include Reggie Littlejohn, founder and President of Women's Rights Without Frontiers, abortion survivor Melissa Ohden, and Rev. Childress, founder of Black Genocide.org

Following the rally, Walkers will march down Market Street to Justin Herman Plaza.

Founded in 2005 by a group of San Francisco Bay Area residents, the Walk for Life West Coast's mission is to change the perceptions of a society that thinks abortion is an answer. Walk participants are expected from throughout the Bay Area and across the United States and Canada.
